



The 2017 Corinthian Friday Night Races

Notice of Race

April 14 to August 25, 2017

1. RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is CYC.
- 1.2 The Sailing Instructions will delete RRS 40 and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment."

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 All sailboats eligible to race in SF-YRA, BAMA or one design events can participate in this series and shall have a 2017 NC-PHRF rating certificate.
- 2.2 The regatta will include PHRF Spinnaker, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, One-Design, and Multihull divisions when sufficient entries have been received to form a class.
- 2.3 One-design classes with 8 or more entrants may request their own start if sufficient entries are received by April 5, 2017.
- 2.4 "Non-Spinnaker" divisions are for boats rated with a spinnaker but choosing not to race with it.
- 2.5 All entries for the Spring Series should be submitted by April 13, 2017. Competitors entering after this date may not have their results reflected in the scoring of the series and as such may be ineligible for series trophies.
- 2.6 All entries not already registered for both Series, entering the Summer Series only, should be submitted by June 15, 2017. Competitors entering after this date may not have their results reflected in the scoring of the series and as such may be ineligible for series trophies.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Fees for the combined Spring and Summer series will be \$150 for entries received before March 21 and \$175 for entries after that date.
- 3.2 Fees for the Spring series only (April 14 to June 9, 2017) will be \$95.
- 3.3 Fees for the Summer series only (June 16 to August 25, 2017) will be \$95.
- 3.4 Fees for an individual race will be \$50. Boats entering a single race will not

be scored as part of any series.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 The series will consist of one race each Friday, conditions permitting, with the first warning signal scheduled at 1815 hours (6:15pm).
- 4.2 The Spring Series will include races from April 14 to June 9.
- 4.3 The Summer Series will include races from June 16 to August 25 with the final race on August 25 not being scored as part of the series.
- 4.4 A minimum of three races will constitute a series.

6 VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 Races will be scored time-on-time under PHRF and one design Class Rules with each series being scored separately under the low point scoring system of appendix A amended such that:
- 7.2 Boats scored DNF, RET, DNS, DSQ or OCS will receive one more point than the number of starters in that race, and boats scored DNC will receive two more points than the number of starters in that race.
- 7.3 The time limit for each race will be sunset as published by the US Naval Observatory. Boats not finishing within the time limit will be scored DNF.
- 7.4 The Spring and Summer Series will be scored separately. In each Series, when fewer than seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. In each Series, when seven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

8 PRIZES

Daily and series trophies will be awarded. A boat representative must be present to accept a Daily trophy.

9 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance policy.
