Notice of Race

1. RULES

- The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is CYC.
- The Sailing Instructions will delete RRS 40 and replaced with:
“Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment.”
- Fleet 1 Articles of Association for J/105 will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at:
<http://www.cyc.org/racing>
- All sailboats eligible to race in SF- YRA, BAMA or One Design events can participate in this series. The regatta will include PHRF, Non-Spinnaker, One Design, and Multihull divisions.
- One Design fleets of 5 or more may have separate scoring while racing in a PHRF division. One Design fleets of 8 or more participants will have separate starts.
- A boat entered without a current NC-PHRF rating that competes in a PHRF division will be assigned a rating by the Race Committee. This includes One Design boats racing in a PHRF division.
- “Non-Spinnaker” divisions are for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, and specified other boats if accepted by the Race Committee. Wyliecats and similar boats shall race in the Spinnaker division. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification, particularly boats not racing in the configuration for which they received their NC-PHRF rating.
PHRF ratings of Knarrs and AE28s shall be adjusted if raced Non-Spinnaker.

3. FEES

For both weekend regattas’, the entry fee will be:

- \$120 for Boats registered before December 25 2016;
- \$140 for Boats registered December 26 to January 13, 2017;
- \$160 for Boats registered after 11pm on January 13, 2017.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- Four races are scheduled in the regatta, with one race each day. Jan Jan 21-22 and Feb 18-19, 2017.
- First Warning Signal is scheduled at noon on all race days.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than Jan 16th on the web site at: <http://www.cyc.org/racing> and on the CYC Clubhouse notice board.

6. VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix T1 section A of *RRS* will apply and will be included in the SI's.

8. SCORING

- Races will be scored time-on-time under PHRF and One Design Class Rules.
- One race must be completed to constitute a series. There will be no throw-outs.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may make radio transmissions to communicate information about time to start and recalls.

10. PRIZES

Daily and series trophies will be awarded.
